Computer and IT News and new developments:

In the coming years, the fastest-growing occupations will be technology professions. The need for computer engineers in the United States will jump from 299,000 to 622,000 jobs by 2008.

Jobs for computer-support specialists will increase from 429,000 to 869,000 during this same time period. And the number of database administrators needed will balloon from 617,000 to an astounding 1.1 million.

The message in these numbers is clear:

If you want to be a part of these growing job markets, one will have to grasp the necessary information Technology skills. The following table gives an overview of different career trends and their future growth in the next 8-10 years. This study was done in 1998 but we observe today that nothing much has changed in these predictions of growth. This table also suggests that there are plenty of opportunities in many different areas along with computers and IT. Special programs and incentives are in place to help people become, and remain, teachers. Teaching has always been rewarding. With \$34,000 starting salaries and other benefits for California teachers, you can also make a good living.
